UEFA Club Monitoring - Deadlines in view of the 2016/17 monitoring process

Dear Licensing Managers,

In accordance with Article 54 (3) of the UEFA Club Licensing and Financial Fair Play Regulations - Edition 2015 (hereinafter: CL&FFP), please find enclosed the key deadlines for the submission to the UEFA Administration of the required monitoring documentation as part of the 2016/17 monitoring process. It shall be highlighted that, subject to cases of force majeure, these key deadlines cannot be extended.

The requested information shall be submitted to the UEFA Administration by use of the CL/FFP IT Solution unless otherwise specified or requested during the monitoring process.

Pursuant to Article 55 (1)(a) CL&FFP, all licensors are required to forward the relevant key deadlines to all their clubs in a timely manner.

Please note that it is your responsibility to set internal deadlines to your clubs for them to submit their monitoring documentation in order for you to perform the necessary assessment procedures for which you are responsible and to submit the validated documentation in due time to the UEFA Administration.

Deadlines for clubs/licensors in order to submit the required club monitoring information to the UEFA Administration via the CL/FFP IT Solution are the following (Article 54(2)(d) CL&FFP):

29	→ <u>Scope</u> : Top division clubs (as a minimum, all licence applicants).
April 2016	 "FS - 2016.01" package covering financial data for the legal entities in the licence applicant's reporting perimeter for their reporting period ending in 2015 (i.e. being the reporting period T-1 for the 2016/17 monitoring period).
15 July	→ <u>Scope</u> : All clubs participating in the 2016/17 UEFA club competitions.
2016	 "CI - 2016.01" package covering the club/legal information for reporting periods ending in 2014 (T-2), 2015 (T-1) and 2016 (T);
	 "OP - 2016.06" package covering no overdue payables information as at 30 June 2016 including Transfer, Employee and Social/tax payables information; and
	 "BE - 2016.06" package covering break-even information for the reporting periods ending in 2014 (T-2) and 2015 (T-1).
17 October 2016	→ <u>Scope</u> : All clubs participating in the 2016/17 UEFA club competitions which have overdue payables as at 30 June 2016, are in breach of an indicator or if otherwise requested by the CFCB Investigatory Chamber.
