UEFA Club Licensing – 2020/21 Key Deadlines

Dear Licensing Managers,

In order to assist you throughout the 2020/21 season please find enclosed the overview of the club licensing deadlines that will need to be respected during the next 12 months.

In particular it should be noted that the submission of the 2021 licensing decisions for the participation in the 2021/22 UEFA club competitions (men's and women's competitions) has been set for 31 May 2021. Therefore, as always please take this into account when defining your core process in accordance with Article 9 of the UEFA Club Licensing and Financial Fair Play Regulations (CL&FFP).

In this respect it should also be noted that as part of the admission procedure for entering the 2021/22 UEFA club competitions, the entire club licensing core process needs to be finalised by the deadline for the submission of the list of licensing decisions to the UEFA administration and any decision communicated after this deadline cannot be taken into account.

DEADLINES FOR THE 2020/21 CLUB LICENSING PROCESS

Dates	Information to be submitted to the UEFA administration by the licensor
30 September 2020	Exception requests in view of 2021/22 season (if applicable) Submission of exception requests in relation to club licensing provisions.
31 December 2020	Revised national club licensing regulations in view of 2021/22 season Submission of the final approved version of national club licensing regulations in accordance with the CL&FFP Regulations (Edition 2018) applicable for 2021 licensing decisions.
1 February 2021	 Three-year rule information and related exception request Submission of exception requests in relation to "Three-year rule"; Submission of the licence applicant/licensee information concerning changes with potential impact on "Three-year rule."
15 April 2021	Extraordinary application in view of 2021/22 season (if applicable) Notification of the possibility of an extraordinary application of the club licensing system.
30 April 2021	 2020 Benchmarking/financial statements in view of 2021/22 season (basis for the break-even information to be submitted in July 2021) Financial statements information for 2020 _ "Financial Information" package; Club Information for 2020 (T)_ "Club Information" package.
31 May 2021	Licensing decisions for 2021/22 season Submission of 2021 licensing decisions for the participation in 2021/22 UEFA club competitions (men's and women's competitions).
